Highly successful and enjoyed by all, the Cotillion was the highlight of the Junior Year.



The Passaic Valley choir and band also performed.









The title to the throne was passed down to members of the family who had escaped, when Omar's father inherited it. Omar's family traveled throughout the Middle East, running from persecution by Communists and enemies. Many threats, including threats of death, were made on the family. They moved to the United States in 1958 due to the American occupation of Beirut. They have been able to live here free from persecution.
